Experienced Board Member Job Description

Activities include regular meeting attendance (currently meet quarterly) with active participation, contributing to the development of plans, ensuring the organization is in compliance with regulations, and evaluating/approving finances and high-level agency decisions. Ideal candidates will have experience in serving other boards, fundraising, and experience with non-profit management. This is an uncompensated volunteer position.

What is expected:

The Board is responsible to:

- support the purpose and mission
- manage the business and affairs
- follow governing documents and policies
- appoint Executive Director
- delegate responsibility of day-to-day operations to designated staff and/or appointed committees
- actively assist with fundraising
- approve the budget
- acquire sufficient funds for operations

Board term/participation

EMA requests that each member of the Board of Directors be able to offer three-five hours of their time per month in service to EMA to attend board meetings, occasional sub-committee meetings, and a commitment to carry out tasks for which they have volunteered. Meetings are held quarterly, and EMA has two to three fundraising events that take place throughout the year.

Additionally, all members of the Board of Directors are asked to complete an Annual Board Intention Form, and are expected to contribute financially to the organization at a level meaningful to them, either through their own monetary gifts or soliciting donors for monetary contributions.
